Under each consultant physician unit, medical SHO on call for COVID should engage for essential wd round in COVID units.

ICU (I) and COVID emergency medical officer roster has be management by MO Anaesthesia.

Contribution by MO roster will be continued by operating minimum number of MO in a given day.

RHO full time release / RHO part time roster by rotation will operate as permanent doctor in 24 A, B, C & E units.

OPD symptomatic assessment unit/ OPD critical care patient handling should be under VP OPD.

24 D, 24 E COVID unit should be operated by a roster comprise of specialized medical consultants. VP - on call is responsible for advising for assessment & management etc.

According to DGHS circular delivering of COVID patient care, all specialist consultant unit is responsible to cater for COVID Positive patients treated in the above mentioned units (24 A, B, C, D & E) and requested perform duties at expected level without fail.
